BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be

14

codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Board of Health shall adopt or amend existing rules relating

16

to a disclosure statement which advises clients of the risks and

17

possible consequences of body piercing or tattoo procedures, to

18

include in such statement that tongue piercing can result in

19

prolonged bleeding, nerve damage and endocarditis, and damage to the

20

teeth and gums.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
