7 [ junk vehicles - requiring title or ownership  
8 records and identification for sale - effective  
9 date ]

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1254A, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1254A. A. Every vehicle offered for sale at salvage  
15 pools, salvage disposal sales, an auction, to a dealer, a licensed  
16 automotive dismantler and parts recycler, or to a junkyard, scrap  
17 metal dealer or car crusher shall be required to present the vehicle  
18 title recognized by the Oklahoma Tax Commission or other ownership  
19 records approved by the Used Motor Vehicle Parts Commission before  
20 the vehicle may be sold. The person shall present his or her photo  
21 identification in the form of a valid state-issued driver license or  
22 state-issued identification card with the title or ownership  
23 records. In addition to presenting proof of identification and  
24 ownership of the vehicle, an inspection to compare the vehicle

1 identification number on the vehicle with the number recorded on the  
2 title or ownership record of the vehicle shall be conducted before  
3 any sale, dismantling, crushing or other disposition of the vehicle.  
4 The inspection shall be conducted at the location or place of  
5 business of the sale and recorded on forms promulgated by the Used  
6 Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission. If the vehicle identification  
7 number on the vehicle offered for sale does not match the number  
8 recorded on the title or ownership record or if the person fails to  
9 present both title or ownership records and photo identification,  
10 the person conducting the inspection shall immediately contact any  
11 state, county or city law enforcement officer who shall be required  
12 to retain the vehicle until such time the law enforcement officer  
13 verifies the vehicle is not stolen. The actual title and completed  
14 inspection forms upon completing the sale shall be submitted to the  
15 Oklahoma Tax Commission. A bill of sale shall not be sufficient  
16 ownership proof without a title or other ownership records  
17 evidencing the person in possession of the vehicle is the current  
18 lawful owner of the vehicle.

19 B. Any person, firm or corporation or employee of person, firm  
20 or corporation in the business of dismantling or salvaging any part  
21 or parts of junked or salvaged motor vehicles shall remove all  
22 license tags attached to ~~said~~ the junked or salvaged motor vehicles  
23 within ten (10) days from receipt of ~~said~~ the vehicle.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1254B, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1254B. Any person ~~in violation~~ violating any provision  
4 of Section ~~4~~ 1254A of this ~~act~~ title shall be guilty of a  
5 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than One  
6 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
