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6 An Act relating to the State Capitol; authorizing  
7 certain licensed vendors to contract for  
8 supplementary catering services during certain time  
9 period; stating requirements; providing for e-  
10 commerce accessibility; requiring approval by State  
11 Capitol Building Manager; authorizing promulgation of  
12 rules; providing for noncodification; and declaring  
13 an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. Any person licensed to operate a snack bar or vending  
18 facility in the State Capitol complex through the Business  
19 Enterprise Program under the authority of the Department of  
20 Rehabilitation Services may, in consultation with the Business  
21 Enterprise Program, contract for supplementary catering services for  
22 the State Capitol complex during the regular legislative session.  
23 Any such contract shall not affect the license or permit of any  
24 person authorized to provide food services through the Business  
Enterprise Program.

1 B. The Department of Rehabilitation Services may also establish  
2 an e-commerce site for the support of such catering services and  
3 food services for the Business Enterprise Program operating in the  
4 State Capitol complex. It shall allow for online ordering and the  
5 receipt of payments online. The Legislative Service Bureau and the  
6 Office of Management and Enterprise Services are authorized to  
7 provide links to any such e-commerce site.

8 C. Any outside vendors contracting to provide services shall  
9 only be allowed to operate during the months of February through May  
10 in temporary facilities, which shall be easily moveable and not  
11 require any significant remodeling, in the State Capitol complex.  
12 Such facilities shall be approved by the State Capitol Building  
13 Manager.

14 D. Any agency affected by the provisions of this act shall be  
15 authorized to promulgate any rules deemed necessary to implement the  
16 provisions of this act.

17 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
