6 An Act relating to the State Charitable Campaign;  
7 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 7007, which relates to  
8 the Oklahoma State Employee Charitable Campaign Act;  
9 authorizing certain entity to share donor contact  
10 information with federations and charitable agencies;  
11 and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 7007, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 7007. A. The state principal combined fund raising  
16 organization shall be a local federation in the State of Oklahoma  
17 that provides, through one specific annual public solicitation for  
18 funds, substantial voluntary financial support for charitable  
19 agencies that depend on public subscription for support in the state  
20 and that has the necessary staff and volunteer support to administer  
21 the charitable contribution campaign.

22 B. The state principal combined fund raising organization shall  
23 have the following duties and responsibilities:  
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- 1        1. Work with the Oversight Committee for State Employee  
2 Charitable Contributions to develop the charitable contribution  
3 campaign plan for the State Charitable Campaign;
- 4        2. Develop the charitable contribution campaign materials and  
5 publicity for the State Charitable Campaign;
- 6        3. Recruit and train the volunteers, departmental coordinators  
7 and solicitors in a bipartisan manner; develop and keep records on  
8 all the accounts to be solicited; and cultivate the accounts to  
9 encourage participation in the charitable contribution campaign;
- 10       4. Keep all fiscal and financial records of the activities and  
11 submit to the Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable  
12 Contributions a separate accounting of all proceeds of the State  
13 Charitable Campaign;
- 14       5. Submit to the participating federations a detailed  
15 accounting of the amount of money designated to the federation and  
16 to each of its member agencies; ~~and~~
- 17       6. Share with the participating federations and charitable  
18 agencies selected by the donating employee, the name, address and  
19 other contact information of the individual donating employee if  
20 such contact information is made available by such employee to the  
21 principal combined fund raising organization; and
- 22       7. Disperse the allocation checks to the participating  
23 agencies.
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1 C. Each state employee shall receive from the state principal  
2 combined fund raising organization general information material with  
3 each federation listed and each of its member agencies listed under  
4 the federation. Each agency and federation shall be identified by a  
5 code number. If descriptions of each agency are used in the general  
6 information material, they shall be provided to the state principal  
7 combined fund raising organization by the federations.

8 D. Each state employee shall be given the option to designate  
9 his or her gifts. Undesignated gifts shall be allocated pursuant to  
10 the provisions of subsection E of this section.

11 E. Undesignated money shall be distributed in the same  
12 proportion as designated dollars within the State of Oklahoma.

13 F. Allocations shall be distributed quarterly; provided, for  
14 campaigns of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or less,  
15 allocations shall be distributed semiannually. Any interest earned  
16 from funds held prior to distribution will be distributed  
17 proportionally to the distribution of undesignated funds.

18 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
