6 [ Pardon and Parole Board - compensation of the Chair  
7 and members of the Board - effective date ]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 332.4, is  
11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 332.4. A. The Chair of the Pardon and Parole Board  
13 shall be selected by the Board. The Chair of the Pardon and Parole  
14 Board shall receive Twenty-four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars  
15 (\$24,800.00) per annum, payable monthly, in the following allotment:

16 1. Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) for preparation for said  
17 meeting; and

18 2. One Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$1,667.00) for  
19 the regular monthly Board meeting.

20 B. The members of the Board shall receive Twenty-two Thousand  
21 Eight Hundred Dollars (\$22,800.00) per annum, payable monthly in the  
22 following allotment:

23 1. Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) for preparation for said  
24 meeting; and

1           2. One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for the  
2 regular monthly Board meeting.

3           In addition to the compensation described above, the Chair and  
4 members of the Board may receive an amount of Thirty-five Dollars  
5 (\$35.00) per hour for work performed with regards to the increased  
6 workload for non-violent parole processing which has become  
7 necessary due to the growth of the prison population on an annual  
8 basis. This compensation shall be limited to an additional fifty-  
9 six (56) hours each month per Board member.

10          C. The members are compensated for the following duties,  
11 including, but not limited to:

- 12           1. Preparation for Board meetings;  
13           2. Performing duties during the regular Board meeting; and  
14           3. Other duties as necessary to carry out the mission of the  
15 Board.

16          D. 1. Failure of any member to attend one Board meeting in any  
17 calendar year, except for justifiable excuse as determined by the  
18 Chair pursuant to written policy established by the Board, shall  
19 preclude the right of the member to receive his or her monthly  
20 compensation established by subsection A or B of this section.

21          2. In addition, any member who fails to attend two or more  
22 Board meetings in any calendar year except for extraordinary  
23 circumstances as determined by the Chair pursuant to written policy  
24 established by the Board shall be deemed to have committed official

1 misconduct as such term is defined by Section 93 of Title 51 of the  
2 Oklahoma Statutes. To initiate a removal from office pursuant to  
3 this paragraph, the Board shall pass a resolution by a majority of  
4 the members of the Board detailing the alleged misconduct. Such  
5 removal shall be subject to the provisions of Chapter 3 of Title 51  
6 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 3. Failure to attend meetings of the Board, pursuant to the  
8 policy established by the Board, shall constitute cause for removal  
9 pursuant to Section 10 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
