10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 5-111, as
12 amended by Section 2, Chapter 10, O.S.L. 2012 (26 O.S. Supp. 2012,
13 Section 5-111), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 5-111. A. Forms to be used for filing Declarations of
15 Candidacy shall be prescribed by the Secretary of the State Election
16 Board and shall contain the following information:

17 1. The name of the candidate; ~~the~~

18 2. The candidate's place of residence and mailing address;

19 3. The name of the office sought; ~~the~~

20 4. The candidate's date of birth;

21 4. The party affiliation of candidate seeking political party
22 nomination;

23 5. The precinct and county wherein the candidate is a
24 registered voter; ~~an~~

1 6. An oath wherein the candidate swears or affirms that he or
2 she is qualified to become a candidate for the office sought, and
3 that, if elected, the candidate will be qualified to hold the
4 office; and ~~any~~

5 7. Any additional information which the Secretary deems
6 necessary.

7 B. If the candidate has ever been convicted of a felony or
8 misdemeanor offense, or at the time of filing the declaration of
9 candidacy is named in an outstanding warrant for arrest, in this or
10 any other state, the form shall further include:

11 1. The name of the offense;

12 2. The date of conviction or issuance of the outstanding
13 warrant;

14 3. The date of restoration of eligibility to become a candidate
15 if such eligibility was barred pursuant to the provisions of Section
16 5-105a of this title;

17 4. The county and state of conviction or issuance of the
18 outstanding warrant; and

19 5. Any additional information which the Secretary deems
20 necessary.

21 C. A Declaration of Candidacy form must be signed by the
22 candidate, and the signature must be properly notarized by a notary
23 public or other person authorized by law to administer oaths.

1 D. In addition to the information required by this section, a
2 candidate may include a telephone number, email address and website
3 address. Such additional information shall not be required of any
4 candidate but if provided shall be made available to the public.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
