19 WHEREAS, American women of every race, class, and ethnic
20 background have made historic contributions to the development,
21 growth and strength of our Nation in countless recorded and
22 unrecorded ways; and

23 WHEREAS, American women have played and continue to play a
24 critical economic, cultural and social role in every sphere of the

1 lives of the people of our Nation by constituting a significant
2 portion of the labor force working inside and outside of the home;

4 WHEREAS, American women have played a unique role throughout the
5 history of our Nation by providing the majority of the volunteer
6 labor force. American women were particularly important in the
7 establishment of the early charitable, philanthropic and cultural
8 institutions of our Nation; and

9 WHEREAS, American women from all walks of life have served as
10 leaders in the forefront of every major movement to restore and
11 safeguard the rights and liberties guaranteed by the Constitution of
12 the United States. They have been leaders, not only in securing
13 their own rights of suffrage and equal opportunity, but also in the
14 abolitionist movement, the emancipation movement, the industrial
15 labor movement, the civil rights movement, and other movements to
16 create a just society for all.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
18 OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
