15 A Concurrent Resolution authorizing the State Capitol
16 Preservation Commission to permit placement of
17 certain Bill of Rights monument on the State Capitol
grounds; stating requirements; and directing
distribution.

20 WHEREAS, the first ten amendments to the Constitution of the
21 United States is commonly referred to as the Bill of Rights; and

22 WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights is the single most powerful and
23 successful assertion of individual rights and liberties ever
24 written; and

1 WHEREAS, the Bill of Rights is one of history's most important
2 and influential documents, with an ingenious balance of personal
3 freedoms and political principles, that has proven dynamic and
4 durable becoming the global road map for human rights and the basic
5 demand of people everywhere seeking freedom from oppression.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
7 OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8 CONCURRING THEREIN:

9 THAT the State Capitol Preservation Commission or designee is
10 hereby authorized to permit and arrange for the placement on the
11 State Capitol grounds of a suitable monument displaying the first
12 ten amendments to the Constitution of the United States, commonly
13 referred to as the Bill of Rights. This monument shall be designed,
14 constructed, and placed on the State Capitol grounds by private
15 entities at no expense to the state. The State Capitol Preservation
16 Commission or designee is authorized to assist private entities in
17 selecting a location for the monument and arranging a suitable time
18 for its placement.

19 THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Governor,
20 and the Chair of the State Capitol Preservation Commission.
