An Act relating to jurors; amending 21 O.S. 2011, Section 388, which relates to attempts to influence jurors; making language gender-neutral; creating felony offense; modifying punishment; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Jurors

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 388, is amended to read as follows:

Section 388. Every person who attempts to influence a juror, or any person summoned or drawn as a juror, or chosen as arbitrator or appointed a referee, in respect to his or her verdict, or decision of any cause or matter pending, or about to be brought before him or her, either:

~~1st,~~ 1. By means of any communication oral or written had with him or her, except in the regular course of proceedings upon the trial of the cause;

~~2nd,~~ 2. By means of any book, paper, or instrument, exhibited otherwise than in the regular course of proceedings, upon the trial of the cause;

~~3rd,~~ 3. By means of any threat or intimidation; or

~~4th, 4.~~ By means of any assurance or promise of any pecuniary or other advantage~~; or,~~

~~5th, By publishing any statement, argument or observation relating to the cause,~~ is guilty of a ~~misdemeanor~~ felony punishable by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary not to exceed ten (10) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
