An Act relating to United States; authorizing counties to maintain certain roads under certain circumstances; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Maintenance of federal roads and highways

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50 of Title 80, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Should any highways or roads located on any property owned and operated by the United States Army Corps of Engineers within the State of Oklahoma close or fail to open for any amount of time due to loss of federal funds in a federal government shutdown or for any other reason, the county in which the road or highway is located may open and maintain the road or highway. This shall be accomplished upon a majority vote of the board of county commissioners that declares the road or highway is needed for an emergency route.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
