An Act relating to environment and natural resources; creating the Environmental Remediation Revolving Fund; listing sources of the fund; authorizing the Secretary of Energy and Environment to budget and expend monies in the fund; directing expenditures from the fund be made under certain conditions; creating the Environmental Programs Revolving Fund; authorizing the Secretary of Energy and Environment to budget and expend monies in the fund; directing expenditures from the fund be made under certain conditions; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Revolving funds

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-103 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet position having authority over the Department of Environmental Quality to be designated the "Environmental Remediation Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Secretary from Natural Resource Damage Assessments on behalf of the state, pursuant to paragraph 4 of subsection A of Section 1-2-101 of Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, that are not designated for

deposit to any other fund as authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-104 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet position having authority over the Department of Environmental Quality to be designated the "Environmental Programs Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Secretary from appropriations, fees, charges, penalties, and any other sources that are not designated for deposit to any other fund as authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
