WHEREAS, the more than 800 archives, libraries and museums in the state are the designated stewards of the culture of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, archives, libraries and museums contribute to the quality of life in every legislative district in the state; and

WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma are highly valued institutions that attract more than 8,000,000 visits each year, support over 4,000 employees and utilize over 12,000 volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma provide important economic benefits to each city, county and the state; and

WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma enhance the reputation of the state worldwide, and their continued presence is integral to cultural tourism programs; and

WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma provide affordable educational experiences for learners of all ages; and

WHEREAS, an engaged and informed citizenry is the foundation of our great state; and

WHEREAS, all Oklahomans benefit from the archives, libraries and museums in the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby expresses appreciation and support for the archives, libraries, museums and other cultural institutions in our state and applauds their efforts to preserve and advance the rich history and culture of the state.
