A Resolution relating to the House of Representatives; establishing an order of business for the House of Representatives for the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature.

WHEREAS, Rule 7.23 of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature requires the Calendar Committee to propose a regular order of business for the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to House Rule 7.23, the Calendar Committee hereby proposes for consideration by the House of Representatives the following daily order of business for the House of Representatives for the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the following Order of Business shall be followed each day:

1. Roll Call;
2. Prayer, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
3. Inspirational Message by Chaplain, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;
4. Introduction of the Veteran of the Week, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

5. Pledge of Allegiance, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

6. Correction of the Previous Day's Journal;

7. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second Reading, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

8. Assignment or Reassignment of Bills and Resolutions, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader;

9. House and Senate Bills and Joint Resolutions on the Consent Calendar;

10. Bills, Resolutions, Conference Committee Reports and Joint Committee Reports scheduled by the House Calendar Committee; and

11. Motions placing new business before the House. The Majority Floor Leader shall schedule said motions upon the same legislative day, the timing of which shall be left to the discretion of the Majority Floor Leader.
