An Act relating to the State Capitol; authorizing certain licensed vendors to contract for supplementary catering services during certain time period; stating requirements; requiring approval by State Capitol Building Manager; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Food service vendors

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. Any person licensed to operate a snack bar or vending facility in the State Capitol complex through the Business Enterprise Program under the authority of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may, in consultation with the Business Enterprise Program, contract for supplementary catering services for the State Capitol complex during the regular legislative session. Any such contract shall not affect the license or permit of any person authorized to provide food services through the Business Enterprise Program.

B. Any outside vendors contracting to provide services shall only be allowed to operate during the months of February through May in temporary facilities, which shall be easily moveable and not require any significant remodeling, in the State Capitol complex.

Such facilities shall be approved by the State Capitol Building Manager.

C. Any agency affected by the provisions of this act shall be authorized to promulgate any rules deemed necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
