An Act relating to tourism and recreation; naming the pavilion at Lake Wister the Henry J. Heflin Pavilion; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Naming recreation facility

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2230.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The pavilion located at the Victor Camping Area at Lake Wister shall be named the "Henry J. Heflin Pavilion".

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
