WHEREAS, Kayla Wilson was named the 2012 Wendy's High School Heisman winner for the State of Oklahoma, a national contest among the country's elite high school athletes based on performance on and off the field; and

WHEREAS, Wilson helped lead the Mooreland Bearcats girls' basketball team to three Orient Conference Championships and three Oil Center Classic Championships where she was named the "Most Inspirational Player" in 2011 as well as a "Top 50 Oklahoma Girls

Basketball Player" by VYPE magazine, the same publication that named her to its All-2A First Team; and

WHEREAS, she also demonstrated athletic success on the track, being named the 2011 2A State Champion in the Long Jump with a jump of 18 feet, 1.75 inches. Wilson also recorded a top-five state finish in the 100 meter dash, and a sixth-place state finish in the 400 meter dash; and

WHEREAS, as a four-year member of the Mooreland High School softball team, Wilson earned All-VYPE, All-Region and All-State recognition her senior year after leading the team to a regional runner-up finish; and

WHEREAS, Wilson served on the student council, serving as president during the 2011-2012 school year. She is also a member of the Oklahoma Honor Society, the National Honor Society, the Superintendent's Honor Roll, Fellowship of Christian Athletes and the Mooreland First United Methodist Youth Group; and

WHEREAS, Wilson, the class Valedictorian, will be graduating from Mooreland High School with a 4.0 G.P.A. and has signed to play basketball at Southwestern College in Winfield, Kansas.
