RESOLUTION NO. 80

A Resolution supporting the National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, unintentional prescription drug overdoses claimed the lives of 534 Oklahomans in 2012; and

WHEREAS, research suggests that as many as one in eight Oklahomans abuse prescription painkillers; and

WHEREAS, prescription drug abuse is a leading cause of death in Oklahomans between ages 18 and 55 and was the number one cause of overdose deaths in Oklahoma in 2013; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, more overdose deaths in Oklahoma involved hydrocodone than methamphetamines, heroin, and cocaine combined; and

WHEREAS, The United States Drug Enforcement Administration's National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse of medications; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control is charged with the collection of prescription drugs submitted during National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day; and

WHEREAS, National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day will be Saturday, April 26, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate encourages all Oklahomans to deposit unused or unneeded prescription drugs at a designated drop-off site.

THAT a copy of this resolution be presented to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and the Eagle Ridge Institute.
