



"B. The Task Force shall consist of fifteen (15) members as follows:

1. The Secretary of Education, or a designee, who shall serve as the chair of the Task Force;

2. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives from the membership of the House;

3. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate from the membership of the Senate;

4. One member representing the State Department of Education appointed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction;

5. One member who represents a statewide association of school board members, selected by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives from a list of recommendations submitted by a statewide association of school board members;

6. One member who represents a statewide organization that represents public school superintendents, selected by the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate from a list of recommendations submitted by a statewide organization that represents public school superintendents;

7. One member who represents a statewide organization that represents parents of public school students, selected by the Governor from a list of recommendations submitted by a statewide organization that represents parents of public school students;

8. Two members who are associated with higher education institutions who have knowledge of psychometrics and statistics, appointed by the Chancellor of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education;

9. Two members who are administrators employed by a public school district, selected by the Governor from a list of recommendations submitted by a statewide organization that represents public school superintendents; and

11. Two members who are classroom teachers employed by a public school district, one selected by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and one selected by the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate from a list of recommendations submitted by a statewide association of school board members."
