1 "SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 82 O.S. 2011, Section 1085.1, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 1085.1 A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Water
4 Resources Board, hereinafter referred to as the Board, consisting of
5 ~~nine (9)~~ ten (10) members to be appointed by the Governor, by and
6 with the advice and consent of the Senate. The Board shall
7 constitute a body corporate and politic and an instrumentality,
8 agency and department of the State of Oklahoma, and exercise by the
9 Board of the powers conferred by this act shall be deemed and shall
10 be held to be an essential governmental function of the State of
11 Oklahoma. ~~One member shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year;~~
12 ~~one member shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years; one~~
13 ~~member shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years; one member~~
14 ~~shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years; one member shall be~~
15 ~~appointed for a term of five (5) years; two members shall be~~
16 ~~appointed for a term of six (6) years; and two members shall be~~
17 ~~appointed for a term of seven (7) years. Upon the expiration of~~
18 ~~said terms, their successors~~ Members shall be appointed for terms of
19 seven (7) years. One member shall be appointed from each of the
20 congressional districts of this state and the remaining members
21 shall be appointed at large. Provided, that after the effective
22 date of this act one member appointed at-large shall reside within
23 the area of the state which is east of United States Highway 69 and
24 south of Interstate Highway 40. However, when congressional

1 districts are redrawn then each member appointed prior to July 1 of
2 the year in which such modification becomes effective shall complete
3 the current term of office and appointments made after July 1 of the
4 year in which such modification becomes effective shall be based on
5 the redrawn districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year
6 in which such modification becomes effective shall be from any
7 redrawn districts which are not represented by a board member until
8 such time as each of the modified congressional districts are
9 represented by a board member. Each member shall be a qualified
10 elector of this state. At all times the membership of the Board
11 shall have represented on it at least one member well versed in each
12 of the following major types of water use: recreational,
13 industrial, irrigational, municipal, rural residential, agricultural
14 and soil conservation work. Not more than two members may be
15 selected representing any one of the major types of water use. The
16 Board shall meet at least once each month. The members of the Board
17 may be removed only for cause. Whenever a vacancy shall occur, the
18 Governor shall appoint a qualified person to fill the unexpired term
19 of the vacant office. Each member of the Board upon entering upon
20 ~~his~~ the duties of the member shall take and subscribe to the
21 constitutional and statutory oath of office and file the same with
22 the Secretary of State.

23 B. The Board shall organize annually by electing a ~~chairman~~
24 chair, ~~vice-chairman~~ vice-chair, and secretary from the membership

1 of the Board, who shall perform such duties as shall be prescribed
2 by the Board.”

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
