1 "C. A licensed professional engineer with expertise in civil or  
2 structural engineering who agrees to voluntarily provide a natural  
3 disaster risk assessment that includes:

4 1. Options for hardening or installation of safe rooms in a  
5 school; or

6 2. Recommendations for safe refuge areas already existing in  
7 the school,

8 shall not be liable for any personal injury, wrongful death,

9 property damage or other loss of any nature related to the

10 individual's acts or omissions in the performance of such

11 professional voluntary services for any school. Nothing in this

12 section shall provide immunity for injury or damage resulting from

13 gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct in rendering the

14 voluntary professional services.

15 D. A law enforcement officer who agrees to voluntarily provide  
16 a dangerous intruder risk assessment that includes:

17 1. Options for hardening or installation of safe rooms in a  
18 school; or

19 2. Recommendations for safe refuge areas already existing in

21 shall not be liable for any personal injury, wrongful death,

22 property damage or other loss of any nature related to the

23 individual's acts or omissions in the performance of such
