I move to amend SB1219 \_\_\_\_\_

Of the printed Bill  
Of the Engrossed Bill

on page 2, line 3, by adding a new Section 2 to read as follows:

"A. All public, private, charter, virtual and home schools in this state shall be required to offer age appropriate health education to all students beginning in sixth grade and continuing each year until graduation from high school. Such course shall include the following information:

1. Abstinence education, the mechanics of impregnation and how to prevent unintended pregnancies;
  2. Education on the various types of sexually transmitted diseases and their prevention. Pregnancy and sexually transmitted disease prevention shall include, but not be limited to, abstinence, the rhythm method, and all forms of contraceptives available to females (intravaginal, intrauterine, implantable and oral, including Plan B One-Step or its generic equivalent and the necessity to obtain a prescription for it);
  3. Instruction on male contraceptive methods including withdrawal, the use of condoms and techniques of proper application, and vasectomy; and
  4. Education on how teen pregnancy affects the likelihood of high school dropout, poverty, and the number of children in foster care.
- B. Each course shall be required to include instruction for a minimum of three (3) hours from a licensed pharmacist in this state.";

and by renumbering the subsequent section.
