1 "SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 288.5C of Title 52, unless there
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Effective July 1, 2013, all duties, assets and obligations
5 of the Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells created
6 pursuant to the Section 700 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes
7 shall be transferred to the authority of the Committee for
8 Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources created pursuant to Section
9 288.5A of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 B. Effective July 1, 2013, the terms of the members of the
11 Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells appointed
12 pursuant to the provisions of Section 700 of Title 52 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes shall be terminated. The members of the
14 Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells serving on June
15 30, 2013, shall on July 1, 2013, become members of a marginally
16 producing oil and gas wells subcommittee of the Committee for
17 Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources.

18 C. Effective July 1, 2013, all unclassified full-time-
19 equivalent, part-time, and temporary employees of the Commission on
20 Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells shall be terminated.
21 Employees shall be paid for any accrued annual leave and may be
22 eligible for other benefits as provided by law.

23 D. Activities and functions previously performed by the
24 Commission on Marginally Producing Oil and Gas Wells shall be under

1 the responsibility of the Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy
2 Resources, or a successor committee as designated by the Oklahoma
3 Energy Resources Board. The Committee may organize itself, create
4 additional subcommittees which are in addition to the marginally
5 producing oil and gas wells subcommittee created in subsection B of
6 this section, or adopt procedures as deemed necessary and
7 appropriate to implement the provisions of this act and carry out
8 the functions and duties of the Commission on Marginally Producing
9 Oil and Gas Wells with the exception of making annual reports as
10 required by paragraph 7 of subsection A of Section 701 of Title 52
11 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Prior to the expenditure of any funds to
12 carry out the functions and duties of the Commission on Marginally
13 Producing Oil and Gas Wells and to implement activities and projects
14 to support marginally producing oil and gas wells, the marginally
15 producing oil and gas wells subcommittee created in subsection B of
16 this section shall have authority to make recommendations to the
17 Committee regarding the expenditures. The Committee shall not make
18 any such expenditure or encumber any funds prior to receiving
19 recommendations from the subcommittee.

20 E. Monies remaining in the Commission on Marginally Producing
21 Oil and Gas Wells Revolving Fund created in Section 705 of Title 52
22 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to credit of the
23 Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources Revolving Fund created in
24

1 Section 288.5B of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes for use as
2 provided in this act.

3 F. The Committee for Sustaining Oklahoma's Energy Resources is
4 authorized to promulgate any rules necessary to implement the
5 provisions of this act. The Secretary of Energy may provide
6 assistance as necessary to oversee the transfer of duties, assets
7 and obligations pursuant to this act."
