Mr./Madame President:

I move to amend the Floor Substitute for Senate Bill No. 164 as follows:

On Page 65, Line 12, by deleting after the semicolon “;” the word “and”; and

On Page 65, Line 23, by inserting after the word “issued” and before the period “.” the following language:

“; and

53. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate – such plates shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the Oklahoma Lupus Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lupus Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 5 of this act”; and

On Page 66, Line 14½, by inserting a NEW SECTION 5, to read as follows:

“SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.24 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee authorized by Section 1135.5 of this title for Lupus Awareness and Education license plates shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund to be designated the "Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund" and administered by the State Department of Health. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of Health pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to the credit of such fund are hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the State Department of Health for the purpose of providing grants to the Oklahoma Lupus Foundation for the purpose of lupus awareness, education, outreach, referral, research or treatment in this state. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.”
