9 An Act relating to courts; authorizing district court
10 judges to carry firearms under certain circumstances;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 129 of Title 20, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A district judge, or retired district judge who receives a
19 statement from the appropriate retirement system verifying the
20 status of the person as a retired district judge, may carry a
21 firearm on his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for
22 personal protection if the person has successfully completed an
23 approved course of firearm training conducted by a state-certified
24

1 firearms instructor which meets the minimum requirements for
2 firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement
3 Education and Training.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
