13 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
14 2011, Section 9030.5, which relates to the Oklahoma
15 Art in Public Places Act; modifying periods of time
during which certain expenditures authorized; and
providing an effective date.

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 9030.5, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 9030.5 A. 1. Except as otherwise provided by
22 subsection C of this section, all state agencies, including
23 institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education,
24 all state departments, boards, councils, and commissions shall

1 allocate, as a nondeductible item out of any expenditures for
2 capital projects including, but not limited to, bond issues for
3 state construction excluding costs for bond issuance and related
4 reserves, an amount of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) of the
5 expenditure to the Oklahoma Historical Society for the purpose of
6 funding the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act, except as otherwise
7 provided by subsection B of this section.

8 2. The maximum assessment for any project shall not exceed Five
9 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). This assessment shall not
10 apply to any private donations for a capital project. This
11 allocation shall be applicable to all state agency capital projects
12 approved by the appointing authority after September 1, 2004. The
13 works of art commissioned pursuant to the Oklahoma Art in Public
14 Places Act may be placed on public lands, integral to or attached to
15 a public building or structure, or detached within or outside a
16 public building or structure.

17 B. 1. Of the assessment provided for in subsection A of this
18 section, four-fifths (4/5) shall be placed in the Commissioning of
19 Art in Public Places Revolving Fund, created in Section 9030.6 of
20 this title, for the commission of any work of art for the Oklahoma
21 Art in Public Places Act. Institutions within The Oklahoma State
22 System of Higher Education shall remain in complete administrative
23 control of their four-fifths (4/5) assessment pursuant to this
24 subsection for the acquisition of art. The remaining one-fifth

1 (1/5) of the assessment shall be reserved for the Art in Public
2 Places Administrative and Maintenance Revolving Fund created by
3 Section 9030.7 of this title.

4 2. Monies deposited in the Art in Public Places Administrative
5 and Maintenance Revolving Fund for the purpose of this moratorium,
6 shall be used for continued administration, educational costs, and
7 maintenance.

8 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not be
9 applicable for the fiscal years ending:

- 10 1. June 30, 2012;
- 11 2. June 30, 2013; ~~and~~
- 12 3. June 30, 2014;
- 13 4. June 30, 2015;
- 14 5. June 30, 2016; and
- 15 6. June 30, 2017.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
