11 An Act relating to resource centers; requiring
12 Department of Human Services to ensure that an entity
13 providing services to certain individuals be assessed
14 annually; providing certain quality standards;
15 requiring certain providers to participate in certain
16 assessments; providing for codification; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1409.1 of Title 10, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The Department of Human Services shall ensure that an entity
23 approved to provide residential services, day services, identified
24 day habilitation, or vocational services to individuals who were

1 residents at the Northern Oklahoma Resource Center of Enid or the
2 Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls Valley on November 1,
3 2012, shall be assessed annually by the Quality Assurance Unit of
4 the Developmental Disabilities Services Division of the Oklahoma
5 Department of Human Services for compliance with contract and policy
6 expectations through the performance review process and successfully
7 complete the fiscal year with no outstanding issues of
8 noncompliance. In assuring the health and safety of these
9 individuals, compliance shall include, but not be limited to,
10 standards related to individual plan implementation, medication
11 administration, staff training, employment background checks, and
12 incident reporting including the reporting of maltreatment. Failure
13 to comply shall result in sanctions as described in Department
14 policy. All such providers shall participate in Oklahoma-Advocates
15 Involved in Monitoring (OK AIM) assessments and all other
16 Developmental Disabilities Services Division quality assurance
17 initiatives designed to assess the quality of service delivery.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
