

1 B. The Chief Information Officer shall develop and maintain an
2 online web presence at the web address "OpenRecords.ok.gov". The
3 site shall allow the public to file a request for documents pursuant
4 to the terms of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

5 C. Upon finding that requested documents are open records under
6 the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act, the Chief
7 Information Officer shall retrieve and deliver the documents to the
8 requester in accordance with the procedures of the Oklahoma Open
9 Records Act.

10 D. Documents requested through the open records web portal
11 shall be delivered to the requester in electronic format.

12 E. Immediately following delivery of the documents requested to
13 the requester, the electronic material shall be made available to
14 the public through the data.ok.gov web portal.

15 F. Nothing in this section shall be construed to change any
16 obligation of public officials to comply with already existing
17 provisions of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
