7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to state government; creating the
9 Public Agency Fee Moratorium Justification and
10 Disclosure of 2013; prohibiting certain entities from
11 creating or increasing fees until date certain;
12 providing for certain statement of fee at the time of
13 payment; defining term; providing for codification;
14 providing for noncodification; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Public Agency
20 Fee Moratorium Justification and Disclosure Act of 2013".

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10.7 of Title 74, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. Unless otherwise provided by law, a moratorium is hereby
 established on all agencies prohibiting any agency from creating any

1 new fees or increasing any current fees. The moratorium shall be in
2 effect until January 1, 2016.

3 B. Any fees charged by an agency, at the time of payment, shall
4 provide a fee justification statement which shall disclose and
5 describe in detail to the entity paying the fee the reason for the
6 fee charged.

7 C. For purposes of this section, "agency" includes but is not
8 limited to any constitutionally or statutorily created state board,
9 bureau, commission, office or authority.

10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
