10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to public finance; imposing duty on
12 certain state government entities with respect to
13 reduction of federal appropriations or federal block
14 grant or other funds; requiring information to be
15 provided to the Director of the Office of Management
16 and Enterprise Services, the Governor, the Speaker of
17 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the
18 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate;
19 imposing requirements for disclosure of federal funds
20 and analysis regarding reliance and costs for
21 compliance; providing for codification; and declaring
22 an emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.42.1 of Title 62, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. Each agency subject to the provisions of the Office of State
2 Finance Act shall develop a contingency plan and corresponding
3 budget to be prepared for up to a twenty-five percent (25%)
4 reduction in any applicable federal monies, whether appropriated or
5 received in block grant or any other form.

6 B. The contingency plan and corresponding budget shall be
7 submitted to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
8 Services, the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
9 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
10 Senate within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this act.

11 C. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section
12 shall make an annual disclosure pursuant to a separate written
13 report and information available through a website maintained by or
14 on behalf of the entity of all federal funds under the control of
15 the entity and the programs for which the federal funds are used by
16 distinct expenditure categories and shall identify the priority or
17 rank of the federal funds in descending order with the funding
18 source the agency relies on to the greatest extent listed first and
19 the funding source the agencies relies on to the least extent listed
20 last. The information required by this subsection shall include,
21 but shall not be limited to:

1 1. A description of any action required to be taken by the
2 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
3 receipt of federal funds;

4 2. A description of any action prohibited to be taken by the
5 state government entity as a condition for the receipt or continued
6 receipt of federal funds;

7 3. A description of any action required to be taken by any
8 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
9 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
10 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
11 federal funds; and

12 4. A description of any action prohibited to be taken by any
13 individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity as
14 a condition for the benefits purported to be conferred on the
15 individual or other legal entity as a result of the use of the
16 federal funds.

17 D. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section
18 shall make an annual disclosure either pursuant to a separate
19 written report, information available through a website maintained
20 by or on behalf of the entity or both, of the federal funds for
21 which the agency must incur costs to implement and shall provide
22 such information in descending order with the most costly federal
23 funds listed first and the least costly federal funds listed last.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
