11 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; prohibiting
12 certain acts relating to low-point beer; providing
13 punishment; providing for codification; and providing
14 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.19A of Title 37, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. No state agency or political subdivision thereof, county or
21 political subdivision thereof, or municipalities or political
22 subdivisions thereof shall use public or private funds, employees or

1 resources to alter, obliterate, mark or modify low-point beer
2 packaging on the premises of a retail dealer.

3 B. No person shall alter, obliterate, mark or modify low-point
4 beer packaging on the premises of a retail dealer.

5 C. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section
6 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined
7 not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or imprisoned in a
8 county jail not exceeding one (1) year or shall be punished by both
9 such fine and imprisonment.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
