14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-2505.2, as
16 amended by Section 489, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (63 O.S. Supp.
17 2012, Section 1-2505.2), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1-2505.2 There is hereby created in the State Treasury
19 a revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated
20 the "Emergency Medical Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund". The
21 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
22 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State
23 Department of Health from the fees imposed pursuant to Section 1-
24 2505.3 of this title and from interest accrued from said monies.

1 All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State
3 Department of Health for the purpose of making death benefit
4 payments to the named beneficiary or personal representative of a
5 deceased emergency medical technician or registered emergency
6 medical responder pursuant to Section 1-2505.1 of this title.
7 Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
8 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
9 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
10 approval and payment.

11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 203, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 203. A. Except as otherwise provided by subsection B
14 of this section, all monies that may come into the State Treasury,
15 ~~pursuant to the provisions of Section 201 et seq. of this title,~~
16 together with all amounts that may be received by the State
17 Treasurer as investment income or as interest on average daily bank
18 balances, including investment income or interest on deposits from
19 funds deposited to the credit of the Constitutional Reserve Fund
20 created pursuant to Section 23 of Article X of the Oklahoma
21 Constitution, shall be apportioned and credited to the General
22 Revenue Fund for the current year.

23 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
24 apply to:

- 1 1. Interest received on deposits from funds under the control
2 of the Commissioners of the Land Office;
- 3 2. Funds in the Department of Human Services Federal
4 Disallowance Fund;
- 5 3. Interest received on deposits from funds under the control
6 of the Santa Claus Commission;
- 7 4. The Risk Management Revolving Fund;
- 8 5. Investment income and interest received from funds in the
9 Quartz Mountain Revolving Fund from insurance claims;
- 10 6. The Drinking Water Treatment Revolving Loan Account and the
11 Drinking Water Treatment Loan Administrative Fund;
- 12 7. The Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan Account and the
13 Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan Administrative Fund;
- 14 8. The State Infrastructure Bank Revolving Fund;
- 15 9. The Nursing Facility Quality of Care Fund;
- 16 10. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving
17 Fund effective July 1, 2003;
- 18 11. The Golf Course Operations Revolving Fund effective July 1,
19 2003; ~~and~~
- 20 12. Interest received on investments from funds in the County
21 Bridge and Road Improvement Fund, the Emergency and Transportation
22 Revolving Fund, the County Road Machinery and Equipment Revolving
23 Fund, the High Priority State Bridge Revolving Fund as created in
24 Section 506 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and the County

1 Improvements for Roads and Bridges Fund as created in Section 507 of
2 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

3 13. The Emergency Medical Personnel Death Benefit Revolving
4 Fund.

5 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
