9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care
10 Authority; directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority
11 to conduct bidding process to select a provider to
12 perform an audit; requiring audit to include certain
13 factors; providing for noncodification; and providing
14 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is directed to conduct a
19 bidding process in which a third party provider shall be selected to
20 perform an audit on the Authority.

21 B. The audit shall include:

- 22 1. Administrative costs and overhead;
23 2. Health outcomes;

1 3. Eligibility criteria for dual eligibility populations as
2 compared to other states; and

3 4. Audit and performance review of total narcotic usage.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
