2 Title ~~51~~ 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for every page contained in  
3 ~~such~~ the copy. Upon demand, the clerk shall furnish a certified  
4 copy in the form as it exists and at the preference of the requestor  
5 as provided by the ~~Oklahoma Open Records Act~~ county clerk fee  
6 schedule.

7 B. If the clerk provides records in an electronic format, all  
8 records shall contain the following information and be searchable by  
9 each of the listed criteria:

- 10 1. Document type;
- 11 2. Complete grantor;
- 12 3. Complete grantee;
- 13 4. Date of instrument;
- 14 5. Date of filing;
- 15 6. Recording information; and
- 16 7. Legal description.

17 C. If the clerk provides records in the form of a compact disc,  
18 the clerk may charge a fee not to exceed twenty-five cents (\$0.25)  
19 per page or Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per compact disc which  
20 shall contain one hundred pages. All recorded instruments  
21 concerning real property required to be kept by the county clerk  
22 shall not be available for reproduction in any other electronic  
23 format. News media obtaining records in an electronic format for a  
24

1 news purpose shall be exempt from the fees provided for in this  
2 subsection.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
