11 An Act relating to public health and safety;
12 permitting assisted living center to participate in
13 informal dispute resolution panel; authorizing State
14 Department of Health to appoint certain panel to be
15 comprised of certain members; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-895 of Title 63, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Upon written request to the State Department of Health, an
22 assisted living center, as defined in Section 1-890.2 of Title 63 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes, may choose to participate in an informal
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1 dispute resolution panel offered by the Department as an alternative
2 to the informal dispute resolution meeting established in Sections
3 1-1914.3 through 1-1914.10 and Sections 1-1914.13 through 1-1914.16
4 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

5 B. The Department shall appoint the informal dispute resolution
6 panel to be comprised of the following impartial members:

7 1. A licensed administrator currently working in assisted
8 living;

9 2. A health professional currently working in assisted living;

10 3. Two representatives of the aging and disabled community who
11 do not represent a state agency; and

12 4. A representative of the Department with experience in
13 supervising the assisted living survey process.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
