



1 of successful completion of ninety (90) clock hours or its  
2 equivalent as determined by the Commission of advanced real estate  
3 instruction in a course of study approved by the Commission, which  
4 instruction shall be in addition to any instruction required for  
5 securing a license as a real estate sales associate, may apply to  
6 the Commission to take an examination for the purpose of securing a  
7 license as a real estate broker or broker associate. The education  
8 required in this subsection shall only be valid for a period of  
9 three (3) years from the date the school certified successful  
10 completion of the course; thereafter, the applicant shall be  
11 required to successfully complete an additional ninety (90) clock  
12 hours or its equivalent in ~~basic~~ advanced real estate instruction.

13 B. Application shall be made upon forms prescribed by the  
14 Commission and shall be accompanied by an examination fee as  
15 provided for in this Code and all information and documents the  
16 Commission may require.

17 C. The applicant shall appear in person before the Commission  
18 for an examination which shall be in the form and shall inquire into  
19 the subjects which the Commission shall prescribe.

20 D. If it shall be determined that the applicant shall have  
21 passed the examination, received final approval of the application,  
22 and paid the appropriate license fee provided for in this Code along  
23 with the Oklahoma Real Estate Education and Recovery Fund fee, the  
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1 Commission shall issue to the applicant a broker or broker associate  
2 license.
