7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to publication of documents; amending
9 65 O.S. 2011, Section 3-114, as amended by Section
10 26, Chapter 358, O.S.L. 2013 (65 O.S. Supp. 2013,
11 Section 3-114), which relates to deposit of state
12 publications; requiring Department of Libraries to
13 publish certain information electronically;
14 prescribing requirements related to failure of
15 agencies to comply with reporting requirements;
16 providing an effective date; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 65 O.S. 2011, Section 3-114, as
20 amended by Section 26, Chapter 358, O.S.L. 2013 (65 O.S. Supp. 2013,
21 Section 3-114), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 3-114. A. Every agency except institutions of higher
23 education, but specifically including any board of regents for
24 higher education, which issues a state publication shall immediately
 file the publication electronically, in compliance with the
 provision of any applicable section of Title 62 of the Oklahoma
 Statutes that is related to submission of state publications. If a

1 state publication cannot be filed electronically, a maximum of
2 twenty-five copies shall be deposited with the Publications
3 Clearinghouse in lieu of the electronic filing and the agency shall
4 include an explanation of the reason the document cannot be filed
5 electronically.

6 B. Upon failure of an agency to comply with the provisions of
7 this section, or with the provisions of Section 34.11.3 of Title 62
8 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Director of the Department of
9 Libraries shall forward a written notice of the failure to the chief
10 administrative officer of the agency. The notice shall state a
11 reasonable time, not to exceed thirty (30) days, in which the agency
12 shall fully comply. Further failure to comply shall be reported in
13 writing to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
14 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Attorney General. The
15 Attorney General shall immediately institute mandamus proceedings to
16 secure compliance by the agency.

17 C. Not less than twice a year, the Director of the Department
18 of Libraries shall cause to be published, and made available through
19 documents.ok.gov, a numeric compilation of each agency's submissions
20 to the Publications Clearinghouse, documents.ok.gov and
21 forms.ok.gov. Additionally, a listing of each agency receiving a
22 notice of failure shall also be published and featured prominently
23 at documents.ok.gov.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
