

1 it is situated. Such schedule of fees may contain one fee for
2 members and another fee for nonmembers, except that no fee shall be
3 established in excess of the approximate cost of providing the
4 service. Any member or nonmember utilizing the services of such a
5 fire department to extinguish or control a fire or provide services
6 in response to an emergency shall be liable to said corporation in
7 the amount of the established fee. However, no fee shall be charged
8 by a fire department for merely appearing at the scene of a
9 controlled fire unless called by the person setting the fire or at
10 such person's request. If it is necessary for suit to be brought
11 for collection of such amount due, such liability shall include
12 costs of suit and a reasonable attorney's fee.

13 B. If insurance coverage is provided for the fee specified in
14 subsection A of this section or for the cost of providing the
15 service rendered by the fire department and an insurer makes payment
16 for the service it shall be the duty of the insured party or the
17 responding fire department to notify the insurer of services
18 rendered. The instrument of payment for the services of the fire
19 department shall be made to the order of the responding fire
20 department and the insured.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
