9 An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2011,
10 Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma Milk and
11 Milk Products Act; providing the act will not
12 prohibit advertising of certain sales of raw milk;
13 requiring raw milk sold in certain manner to be
14 unpasteurized; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-414, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk
19 Products Act shall not be construed to:

20 1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers
21 at the farm where the milk is produced;

22 2. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sales of raw
23 milk;

24 3. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat
milk; and

1 ~~3.~~ 4. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
2 milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.

3 B. A provider of raw milk sold in outside road stands shall be
4 unpasteurized raw milk. Raw milk could be hazardous to unborn
5 children.

6 C. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
7 are those sales where the average monthly number of gallons sold
8 does not exceed one hundred (100).

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
