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9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to state government; making certain
11 reports and assessments of the Oklahoma Information
12 Fusion Center confidential; authorizing disclosure to
13 certain persons; making collected information
14 privileged and not discoverable; providing an
15 exception; providing for codification; and providing
16 an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.21c of Title 74, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. The information reports and intelligence assessments of the
22 Oklahoma Information Fusion Center shall be confidential and shall
23 not be open to the public; provided, however, members of the

1 Oklahoma Information Fusion Center may disclose, at the discretion
2 of the Oklahoma Information Fusion Center Director, such Fusion
3 Center information reports and intelligence assessments to:

4 1. Officers and agents of federal, state, county, or municipal
5 law enforcement agencies and appropriate prosecutorial authorities
6 for criminal investigation, criminal prosecution, crime prevention,
7 public safety, and Homeland Security purposes; and

8 2. Critical infrastructure and key resources personnel in the
9 private sector and other necessary private sector security officials
10 authorized by the Oklahoma Information Fusion Center Director to
11 receive such reports for public safety and Homeland Security
12 purposes.

13 B. Information collected and compiled under the authority of
14 this section shall be privileged and not discoverable, nor subject
15 to subpoena or order for production issued by any court, other than
16 production in a district court criminal proceeding for the
17 prosecution of crimes which are the subject of the information
18 sought.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
