9 An Act relating to technology; establishing the
10 Oklahoma State Privacy Protection and Transparency
11 Initiative; directing the Chief Information Officer
12 to develop and maintain a public access web-based
13 data object catalog; requiring certain definitions
14 when possible; requiring the sharing of data objects
15 to be itemized and detailed in the catalog; providing
16 for application to certain databases; providing for
17 codification; providing an effective date; and
18 declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.11.11 of Title 62, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. There is hereby established the Oklahoma State Privacy
24 Protection and Transparency Initiative.

 B. The Chief Information Officer shall develop and maintain a
publicly accessible web-based catalog listing each data object
collected by state government entities.

1 C. When possible, data objects shall be accompanied by a
2 definition allowing the reader to understand the purpose of the
3 object and providing a description of the data which is in each
4 object.

5 D. The catalog created in accordance with subsection B of this
6 section shall specifically itemize and detail the interagency and
7 intergovernmental sharing of data objects between state government
8 entities and between state government entities and non-state-
9 government entities.

10 E. The requirements of this section shall apply to any database
11 created by employees of the Information Services Division of the
12 Office of Management and Enterprise Services after the effective
13 date of this act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
