8 An Act relating to public health and safety;
9 requiring Medicare home care agency to adopt certain
10 policy; requiring certain applicants to undergo drug
11 testing; providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1971A of Title 63, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Each Medicare home care agency, as defined in Section 1-1961 of
18 Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be required to adopt a
19 written random drug-testing policy as set forth in Section 555 of
20 Title 40 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
