7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to poor persons; directing the
9 Oklahoma Health Care Authority to apply for certain
10 waiver; prohibiting Authority from accepting certain
 federal funds; providing for codification; and
 providing an effective date.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.14 of Title 56, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is directed to apply for
18 a waiver or waivers to the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare
19 Services (CMS) that would allow the state to adopt eligibility
20 criteria for the state Medicaid program that would have the effect
21 of reducing any inadvertent antimarriage penalties.

22 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall be prohibited from
23 accepting additional federal funds in order to accomplish the
24 purpose set forth in subsection A of this section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
