



1 B. As used in this section, "cyber spying" means the act or  
2 practice of obtaining secrets without the permission of the holder  
3 or the information, regardless of whether the information is  
4 personal, sensitive, proprietary, or of a classified nature, from  
5 individuals, competitors, rivals, groups, governments, and enemies  
6 for personal economic, political, or military advantage using  
7 methods on the Internet, networks or individual computers through  
8 the use of cracking techniques and malicious software, including but  
9 not limited to, Trojan horses and spyware. It may be wholly  
10 perpetrated online or may involve infiltration by computer.

11 C. The Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security is hereby directed  
12 to prevent cyber spying by any international, federal and state  
13 government agency, educational institution, corporate entity or  
14 individual, regardless of any source of funding or resources, and  
15 shall provide for individual privacy rights of all Oklahoma  
16 citizens.

17 D. It shall be unlawful for any international, federal and  
18 state government agency, educational institution, corporate entity  
19 or individual to commit the act of cyber spying on any Oklahoma  
20 citizen. Any violation of this section shall be punishable by a  
21 fine of not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per  
22 incident. In addition, a written explanation of the violation shall  
23 be posted on the primary state website of the violator.
