8                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9                   An Act relating to statutes and reports; restricting  
10                   certain provisions related to Section 46 of Article V  
11                   of the Oklahoma Constitution; defining terms;  
12                   providing for codification; and providing an  
13                   effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
16                   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11c of Title 75, unless there is  
17                   created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18                   For purposes of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes the  
19                   constitutional provision found in Section 46 of Article V of the  
20                   Oklahoma Constitution dealing with the prohibition of local and  
21                   special laws on certain subjects is restricted to the following  
22                   definition and all case law to the contrary is hereby null and void:

23                   1. "Local laws" shall mean those laws confined in their  
24                   application to a geographic subunit of the State of Oklahoma; and

2. "Special laws" are those that favor a particular person or corporation without reference to location.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
