



1 that parents receive a tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (Tdap)  
2 vaccine during the postpartum period to protect their newborns from  
3 the transmission of pertussis.

4 B. Nothing in subsection A of this section shall be construed to  
5 require any hospital to provide or pay for any vaccinations against  
6 pertussis.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
