3 C. The Chief Information Officer shall promulgate procedures by
4 which each state agency, board, commission, and public trust having
5 the State of Oklahoma as a beneficiary shall submit a searchable
6 electronic version of each publication to the ~~"documents.ok.gov"~~
7 documents.ok.gov website. The procedures shall require submission
8 to the site of all publications otherwise required by law to be
9 submitted to either the Publications Clearinghouse of the Department
10 of Libraries, the Governor, the Speaker of the House of
11 Representatives or the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. The
12 procedures shall require the electronic documents to be provided in
13 an indexed format which enables the document to be searched by
14 specific term.

15 D. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
16 Services shall cause the complete budget worksheets of each state
17 agency to be made available to the public through documents.ok.gov.
18 Worksheets for each fiscal year and for each of the ten (10) years
19 preceding the effective date of this act shall be made available.

20 E. State agencies, boards, commissions, and public trusts
21 having the State of Oklahoma as a beneficiary shall comply with
22 procedures promulgated pursuant to the terms of this section.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.
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1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
