10                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
12                   2011, Section 662, which relates to the display and  
13                   preservation of historical documents; modifying  
14                   display and preservation of certain artifacts and  
15                   documents; authorizing Secretary of State to elect  
16                   alternate location for preservation of the original  
17                   State Constitution; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19                   SECTION 1.            AMENDATORY            74 O.S. 2011, Section 662, is  
20 amended to read as follows:

21                   Section 662. A. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized  
22 and directed to ~~establish secured display areas for~~ take measures  
23 necessary for the preservation and care of the original State  
24 Constitution, ~~photographs and other documents and articles of~~  
~~historical significance.~~ The

1        B. Except as otherwise provided by subsection C of this  
2 section, the original State Constitution or its replica, and other  
3 historically significant artifacts and documents, shall be publicly  
4 displayed in a display case an area to be designated by the  
5 Secretary of State in the State Capitol Building. The display area  
6 shall be under the jurisdiction and control of the Secretary of  
7 State.

8        C. The Secretary of State is authorized to elect an alternate  
9 secure location on state-owned property for the preservation or  
10 exhibition of the original State Constitution if the display of the  
11 original document in the State Capitol Building would place the  
12 document at risk for damage from heat, cold, light, moisture or  
13 other environmental factors which in the judgment of the Secretary  
14 of State requires display or storage of the original document in an  
15 alternate location.

16        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
