10                                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to environment and natural resources;  
12                   creating the Federal Clean Water Act Grant Revolving  
13                   Fund; listing sources of the fund; authorizing the  
14                   Secretary of Energy and Environment to budget and  
15                   expend monies in the fund; directing that  
16                   expenditures from the fund be made under certain  
17                   conditions; creating the Environmental Programs  
18                   Revolving Fund; authorizing the Secretary of Energy  
19                   and Environment to budget and expend monies in the  
20                   fund; directing that expenditures from the fund be  
21                   made under certain conditions; providing for  
22                   codification; and providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-103 of Title 27A, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

                  There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet

1 position having authority over the Department of Environmental  
2 Quality to be designated the "Federal Clean Water Act Grant  
3 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject  
4 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received  
5 by the Secretary from gifts, grants, private donations or federal  
6 funding that are not designated for deposit to any other fund as  
7 authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund  
8 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the  
9 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from  
10 said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
11 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the  
12 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and  
13 payment.

14 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2-104 of Title 27A, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
18 for the Secretary of Energy and Environment or the successor cabinet  
19 position having authority over the Department of Environmental  
20 Quality to be designated the "Environmental Programs Revolving  
21 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal  
22 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the  
23 Secretary from appropriations, fees, charges, penalties, and any  
24 other sources that are not designated for deposit to any other fund

1 as authorized by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said  
2 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the  
3 Secretary to perform the duties imposed by law. Expenditures from  
4 said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
5 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the  
6 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and  
7 payment.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
