



- 1           1. Pay professional expenses of the Administrator of the  
2 Authority, including dues, licenses, professional memberships, and  
3 continuing education classes conducted in the State of Oklahoma; and  
4           2. Pay professional expenses of any Oklahoma licensed  
5 physician, including dues, licenses, professional memberships,  
6 continuing medical education classes conducted in the State of  
7 Oklahoma, and medical malpractice insurance, provided the physician  
8 is a full-time employee of the Authority in accordance with  
9 subsection B of Section 5006 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes or  
10 paragraph 1 of subsection B of Section 840-5.5 of Title 74 of the  
11 Oklahoma Statutes and utilizing those professional skills in the  
12 performance of their job duties.

13           SECTION 2. In order to facilitate cash management of federal  
14 grant receipts and disbursements, the Office of Management and  
15 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies between the Oklahoma  
16 Health Care Authority federal and revolving funds in amounts  
17 requested by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

18           SECTION 3. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to  
19 transfer funds from Fund 205 to Fund 340 in quarterly installments  
20 to satisfy claims made to the Authority under the Supplemental  
21 Hospital Offset Payment Program Act.

22           SECTION 4. A. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care  
23 Authority may request in the manner provided in this section that  
24 receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded after

1 July 1, 2014, be exempt from expenditure limitations and from  
2 budgetary limitations.

3 1. The Administrator shall make a request for exemption to the  
4 Office of Management and Enterprise Services in writing and file a  
5 revised budget program.

6 2. The Administrator shall also file copies of the request for  
7 exemption and budget work program revisions with the Oklahoma House  
8 of Representatives Appropriations and Budget Committee Chair and the  
9 Oklahoma State Senate Appropriations Committee Chair. The Oklahoma  
10 House of Representatives Appropriations and Budget Committee Chair  
11 and/or the Oklahoma State Senate Appropriations Committee Chair  
12 shall notify the Office of Management and Enterprise Services of any  
13 noncompliance of the request with legislative intent within twelve  
14 (12) calendar days of their receipt of the exemption request.

15 B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall  
16 approve the request for exemption unless both the Chair and Vice  
17 Chair of the Joint Legislative Committee on Budget and Program  
18 Oversight provide written notification to the Office of Management  
19 and Enterprise Services within twelve (12) calendar days of the  
20 Committee's receipt of the exemption request that the exemption  
21 subverts the intention and objectives of the Legislature in  
22 establishing the original limit. The Office of Management and  
23 Enterprise Services shall give written notice of approval or  
24 disapproval of each exemption to the agency, the Governor and the

1 Chair of the Oklahoma House of Representatives Appropriations and  
2 Budget Committee and the Chair of the Oklahoma State Senate  
3 Appropriations Committee within eighteen (18) calendar days of  
4 receiving the request.

5 SECTION 5. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services  
6 shall transfer monies appropriated from the General Revenue Fund and  
7 the 245 Fund to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority disbursing funds  
8 in the amounts and ratios requested by the Authority except that the  
9 cumulative amount transferred shall not exceed the cumulative amount  
10 of equal monthly allotments of the appropriation from the General  
11 Revenue Fund. Monies appropriated or collected for the fiscal year  
12 ending June 30, 2015, may be transferred to these disbursing funds  
13 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, to satisfy encumbrances  
14 and obligations of said fiscal year; provided, that monies equal in  
15 amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the  
16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, to the disbursing fund for the  
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, to satisfy encumbrances and  
18 obligations of said fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in  
19 writing to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. The  
20 Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall maintain records of the inter-  
21 year transfers.

22 SECTION 6. The Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care  
23 Authority may request through the Director of the Office of  
24 Management and Enterprise Services the early transfer by the

1 Oklahoma Tax Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue  
2 Fund for the purpose of early allocation to the agency's disbursing  
3 funds to alleviate cash-flow problems.

4 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by Sections 63-66 of Enrolled  
5 Senate Bill No. 2127 of the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma  
6 Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay  
7 purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015  
8 (hereafter FY-15) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June  
9 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16). Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be  
10 encumbered only through June 30, 2015, and must be expended by  
11 November 15, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, and  
12 not budgeted for FY-16, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund  
13 for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be  
14 encumbered only through June 30, 2016. Any funds remaining after  
15 November 15, 2016, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for  
16 the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be  
17 budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-  
18 15, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be  
19 budgeted for FY-16, after the agency to which the funds have been  
20 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
21 revision removing these funds from the FY-15 budget work program and  
22 after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management  
23 and Enterprise Services.

24 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

1       SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
