8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Joint Resolution disapproving permanent rule of the
10 State Board of Career and Technology Education;
11 stating legislative intent; and directing
12 distribution.

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 250.2 and 308 of Title 75 of the
14 Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature reserves the right to designate
15 the method for rule promulgation, establish policy, determine that a
16 rule is not consistent with legislative intent and disapprove any
17 rule or portion thereof at any time; and

18 WHEREAS, permanent rule OAC 780:15-3-5, subsection (c),
19 paragraph (1), subparagraph (E), which reads in part, "In the event
20 the board of education of the technology center district will not
21 give written approval of the deannexation, then school district
22 electors of the entire technology center district shall be eligible
23 to vote on the deannexation question.", which was promulgated by the

1 State Board of Career and Technology Education, does not reflect the
2 intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 SECTION 1. The Legislature hereby disapproves the second
6 sentence of the following permanent rule which was promulgated by
7 the State Board of Career and Technology Education: OAC 780:15-3-5,
8 subsection (c), paragraph (1), subparagraph (E), which reads, "In
9 the event the board of education of the technology center district
10 will not give written approval of the deannexation, then school
11 district electors of the entire technology center district shall be
12 eligible to vote on the deannexation question.", which does not
13 reflect the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature.

14 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is directed to distribute
15 copies of this resolution to the Governor, the State Board of Career
16 and Technology Education, and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
